A Profile of Auniati University, Teok

The Auniati University is a private university founded in 2023 under the Auniati University Act (Assam Act No. XXXIX of 2022). Established under the aegis of Sri Sri Auniati Satra, Majuli in Assam, the largest Vaishnavite monastery of the state, which came into being consequent to the bhakti movement led by Mahapurush Sri Sri Shankaradeva, Damodardev, Harideva, Madhabdeva and other Bhakti Saints of Assam in the early 16th century. Inspired by the Satriya culture, based on traditional Indian ideals, Auniati University is committed to offering state-of-the-art education in the 64 kalas including science, medicine, and technology, and creating a research environment relevant to the social, cultural, and moral needs of the society. The University is established by the 'Auniati Socio-cultural and Educational Development Trust' under Sri Sri Auniati Satra, with its headquarters in Majuli, Assam.

In an era marked by rapid technological advancement and globalization, the moral and ethical fabric of society is increasingly being challenged. While academic excellence remains a cornerstone of higher education, there is a growing need to instill in students the values that shape responsible, empathetic, and conscientious citizens. Auniati University, established under the visionary leadership of His Excellency, Sri Sri Dr. Pitambar Devagoswami, emerges as a unique institution with a mission that transcends conventional academic goals. It aspires to reintroduce the essence of ethics, morality, and spiritual consciousness into mainstream education - thereby nurturing not just informed minds, but enlightened souls.

The foundation of Auniati University is deeply inspired by the age-old Vaishnavite traditions of Assam, which emphasize humility, non-violence, self-discipline, truthfulness, and service to others. These values are integrated into the University's academic philosophy, student life, and community outreach. In contrast to the growing trend of individualism, consumerism, and detachment from cultural roots, Auniati University positions itself as a sanctuary of values where education is not merely about acquiring degrees, but about developing character.

The University believes that the ultimate aim of education is not only to prepare students for careers but also to shape them into moral leaders and socially responsible individuals. Therefore, moral education is interwoven across all academic programs. Students are encouraged to reflect upon their responsibilities towards society, the environment, and future generations. Regular discourses, value education classes, workshops on ethics, and service-learning opportunities form an integral part of the learning process.

While firmly grounded in spiritual values, Auniati University is also committed to academic rigor and practical relevance. The University offers a balanced curriculum that combines modern disciplines such as Economics, Political Science, Mass Communication, Library Science, Sociology, and others with value-based education. Through this integrated approach, students gain a holistic understanding of the world-one that empowers them intellectually and ethically.

The promotion and preservation of cultural heritage is another pillar of the University's mission. Auniati University takes pride in promoting the rich legacy of the Satriya culture - a spiritual and artistic tradition unique to Assam - through advanced research, cultural programs, and academic collaborations. This endeavor not only keeps indigenous knowledge systems alive but also allows students to connect with their cultural identity while contributing to global conversations about tradition and modernity.

The University operates through three vibrant campuses. The main campus is located in Teok, Jorhat, with additional campuses in Majuli - the cultural heart of Assam - and North Guwahati. Each campus offers a serene and eco-friendly environment, conducive to deep learning and contemplation. The Majuli and Guwahati campuses are blessed with scenic riverine views that provide students with both aesthetic pleasure and spiritual inspiration.

Main Campus, Teok: Auniati University:

The university's main campus lies approximately 3 kilometers east of Teok town and around 30 kilometers from Jorhat, along National Highway 37. This convenient yet peaceful location allows for both accessibility and seclusion - ideal conditions for focused academic engagement and meaningful personal development. Spread across 63 bighas of elevated land, the campus provides a naturally inspiring environment. Surrounded by the age-old wisdom and cultural legacy of the Auniati Satra, the university stands as a confluence of tradition and modern higher education. Here, learning transcends the boundaries of classrooms, as the spiritual ambiance and the natural surroundings create a holistic educational experience that nurtures both intellect and character.

At the postgraduate level, the university provides advanced academic training in the disciplines of Assamese, Performing Arts, and Sociology.

For research scholars, Auniati University offers PhD programs in Assamese, Economics, Education, English, Folklore, Geography, Library and Information Science, Performing Arts, Philosophy, Political Science, and Sociology.

To further expand learning opportunities and community engagement, the university offers Certificate Courses in Performing Arts.

Majuli Campus: Sri Sri Duttadeva Goswami Integrated Campus, Auniati University:

Located in the peaceful and culturally rich island of Majuli, the Sri Sri Duttadeva Goswami Integrated Campus of Auniati University offers special courses in the traditional art forms of Assam. Under the Faculty of Performing Arts, students can take six-month certificate courses in Satriya music (Gayan Sāili), instrumental music (Bayan Sāili), and dance (Nritya Sāili).

Sri Sri Hemchandra Deva Goswami Constituent Campus: North-Guwahati

Sri Sri Hemchandra Deva Goswami Constituent Campus of Auniati University is located on the pristine north bank of the mighty river Brahmaputra with vast natural scenic beauty on the front part of the campus. The campus is enriched with beautiful and well-ventilated classrooms and halls, very rich museum with ancient valuables with beautifully crafted jewelry, pottery, royal clothings and armories, manuscripts on tree barks (*Sanchi paat*) etc., a modern integrated library, a Guest house with AC and Non-AC rooms, two auditoriums, a

beautiful Outdoor Gallery for cultural activities, exhibitions etc, play grounds on the bank of the Brahmaputra. The Campus is well located with transportation services by rail, road and air services, ferry services from three different ferry ghats across the Brahmaputra and one Ropeway over the Brahmaputra to reach Guwahati, the capital and Commercial city of Assam. Currently 34(thirty-four) students of first batch of Certificate Course in Performing Arts are completing their Six – Months course in subjects like Gayan, Bayan and Nrity Sali of Classical Satriya form of Songs, Music and Dance.

Celebration of International Women's Day at Auniati University

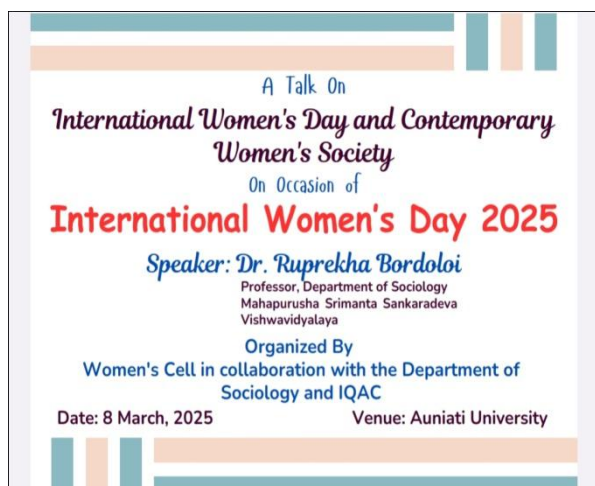

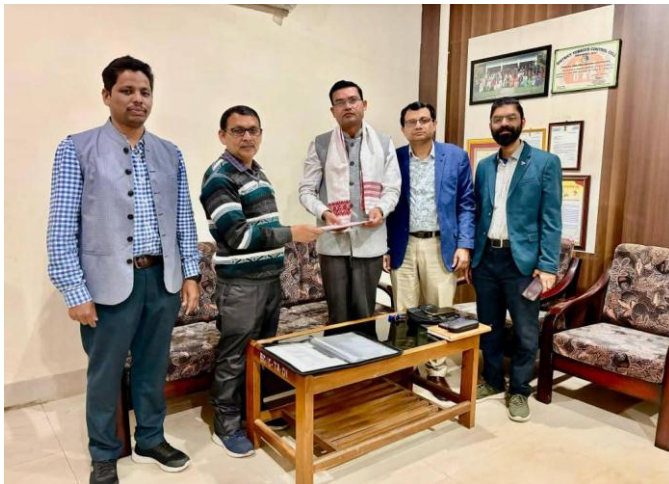
